





PERSONAL ALARMS | ALARM MONITORING SYSTEM

An alarm monitoring system is usually connected to a centre 24/7. It is a telephone system with a two-way speaker and a portable emitter (bracelet or pendant) that is activated by the wearer in an emergency. Options vary by company and include fall detectors, or an integrated GPS to locate a person who has cognitive difficulties and wanders (due to illnesses such as Alzheimer's).


